### MAJOR PRIZES

#### Mil-Pra AECG Award

The 2018 theme for Mil-Pra AECG Award is "Because of Her". This \$1,000 award is open only to artists whose work reflects the theme. It is sponsored by CPAC and the Mil-Pra AECG. The winning artwork is selected by the Mil-Pra AECG committee.

#### Bruce & Carol Kendall OAM Memorial Award

This \$500 award is open to all adult artists. It acknowledges and celebrates Bruce and Carol Kendall's contribution to the Mil-Pra AECG.

#### Maria Lock Acquisitive Award\*

This award is open to all adult artists. It is in recognition of Maria Lock, the first Aboriginal woman to be granted land. The winning artwork is acquired for the Liverpool City Council Collection. The maximum acquisition amount is \$2,000.

#### Mayor's Choice Acquisitive Award\*

This award is open to all adult artists. The winning artwork is selected by the Mayor of Liverpool City Council for the Liverpool City Council Collection. The maximum acquisition amount is \$3,000.

#### KARI Award

Sponsored by KARI, this prize is open to all adult artists.  
1st prize: \$400  
2nd prize: \$200

#### Kate Nicholas Liverpool Women's Services Award

This \$500 award, in memory of Kate Nicholas, is open to all adult female artists and is sponsored by Liverpool Women's Resource Centre, Liverpool Women's Health Centre and Bonnie Support Services.

#### Family and Early Childhood Art Award

This award is open to families with young children under school age, children attending open play, playgroups and/or Early Childhood settings.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

---

The Mil-Pra AECG Aboriginal Exhibition is only open to adult Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists living in NSW and the ACT. The student awards are open to any students of the appropriate age.

## **EXHIBITION CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

---

Artists may submit up to three artworks that must not exceed 150cm by 150cm (and 100cm for 3D works). Any medium accepted. All artworks must be ready for display with D-rings or alternate display hardware attached at time of delivery. The artwork must be the original work of the artist. Artworks must have been produced in the last 24 months and be the property of the artist or their agent. Artworks by groups of eligible artists may be entered. Please read the full Terms and Conditions.

## **HOW TO ENTER**

---

## **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

---

1. All participating adult artists must be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent. All adult artists must be 18 years of age or older at the date of the exhibition. Proof of age may be required.
2. All judges will be appointed by the exhibition sponsors in consultation with Casula Powerhouse Arts Centre (CPAC). Artists who have entered artworks or whose children have entered artworks are ineligible to judge any of the awards. The decision of the judge/s will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
3. All exhibiting artists will permit their artworks to be reproduced in print and electronic media for the purpose of advertising and promoting the Annual Mil-Pra AECG Aboriginal Exhibition. CPAC reserves the right to reproduce artworks in subsequent promotional material with appropriate artist credit.
4. Artists are responsible for organising all transport matters including costs of the delivery and collection of their artworks.
5. All artworks must be ready for display with D-rings attached to the back of the work. If D-rings are not suitable for display the work must come with an alternate hanging system (i.e. pins should be supplied for unframed paper works). CPAC will not accept any artworks that are not ready for display or are wet, incomplete, structurally unstable, or damaged in any way. CPAC will not repair any artworks on the artist's behalf.
6. Artworks may be photographed for educational/promotional purposes while on display in the exhibition.
7. All artworks will be available for collection unwrapped. Any artists wanting to wrap their works will need to bring all wrapping or packaging with them and wrap the artworks themselves.
8. CPAC reserves the right to refuse and/or withhold any artwork from display at its own discretion.
9. All adult artworks available for sale for \$100 or more will be subject to 20% commission. 10% payable to CPAC and 10% payable to Mil-Pra AECG. All artworks available for sale for \$99 or less will not be subject to any commission.
10. Student artworks are not for sale.
11. CPAC will ensure the artwork(s) are insured in the interests of all parties against loss or damage from the time the artworks are received at CPAC until the time the artwork(s) are collected by the entrant. An insurance value must be declared for each entered artwork on the Registration Form. Works without an insurance value will not be accepted. A nominated insurance value is based on fair replacement cost.
12. You must nominate if you want to enter the Mayor's Choice Acquisitive Award. If entered, the maximum amount paid to the winner is \$3,000. Liverpool City Council will not pay more than this nominated amount even if the painting is valued above \$3,000. By entering this award, you acknowledge that if won, the work will be acquired into the Liverpool City Council Collection.
13. You must nominate if you want to enter the Maria Lock Acquisitive Award. If entered, the maximum amount paid to the winner is \$2,000. Liverpool City Council will not pay more than this nominated amount even if the painting is valued above \$2,000. By entering this award, you acknowledge that if won, the work will be acquired into the Liverpool City Council Collection.
14. All submitted details on the registration form are final. Changes can NOT be made at delivery.
15. Artworks to be collected on 9 February 2019 10:30 – 4:00pm. If you require a later pick up date, this must be arranged with CPAC Registration staff prior to 8 February 2019. Artwork not collected on the collection date may be disposed of at the discretion of CPAC staff. Early pick up is not available.
