


Koori Floor is a reminder that we are always 'walking lightly upon Aboriginal land.'

It is made of coated concrete flooring, viewing 'pools' and objects significant to the land.

This represents the Georges River.



DID YOU KNOW

the light 'pools' contain items that represents some artefacts: kangaroo rib bones, echidna quills, river shells, seed pods, charcoal, quartz and a small Aboriginal flag.
